Resolution to call for a public hearing for Town Law 2021-01 for the Town to opt out of the Real Property Tax Law section 487 exemption for property tax for wind, solar, and farm to energy systems.

Town of Lisbon Law 2021-01

<u>WHEREAS</u>, paragraph 2 of Section 487 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York (the RPTL) provides that real property, which includes solar or wind energy system or farm waste to energy systems approved in accordance with the provisions of such section shall be exempt from taxation to the extent that any increase in the value thereof by reason of the inclusion of such solar or wind energy system or farm waste to energy system for a period of fifteen (15) years; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, paragraph 8 of Section 487 of the RPTL provides that, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 2 of Section 487 of the RPTL, a Town may by Town Board Resolution provide that no exemption under Section 487 of the RPTL shall be applicable within its jurisdiction with respect to any solar or wind energy system, or farm waste to energy systems constructed subsequent to the effective date of such Town Board Resolution; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Town Board of the Town of Lisbon is desirous to and wishes to exercise the right to opt out of paragraph 2 of Section 487 of the RPTL pursuant to the rights granted to it pursuant to paragraph 8 of Section 487 of the RPTL; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a paragraph 8 of Section 487 of the RPTL, a copy of this Town Board Resolution shall be filed with the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority, the New York State Office of Real Property Services, the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance, the St Lawrence County Clerk, and the St Lawrence County Office of Real Property, and

WHEREAS the Town of Lisbon hereby exercises its right to opt out of the real property tax exemption of Section 487 of the RPTL, pursuant to the authority granted to it pursuant paragraph 8 of Section 487 of the RPTL, and therefore provides that no exemption shall hereafter be provided under that section for any property located in the Town of Lisbon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, a public hearing on said proposed Local Law No. 2021-01 shall be held on the 9th day of January, 2021 at 6 o'clock P.M. Eastern Time, at the Town Hall, upstairs auditorium, 6963 County Route 10, in the Town of Lisbon, New York. Notice of the time and place of such public hearing describing in general terms the proposed local law, be published in accordance with Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, which prescribes a five-day newspaper notice period for a public hearing on a local law, and posted on the Town website and the official bulletin board outside the Town Clerks Office. The Town Clerk shall file an affidavit of publication after publishing the notice, in order to prove that the request for publication was made.

TOWN OF LISBON RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL RESERVE FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE HIGHWAY EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND.

WHEREAS, this Board is in the process of establishing a five year financial plan and a 5 year capital purchase plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined it to be prudent and responsible to establish a reserve fund pursuant to §6-c of the New York General Municipal Law for the inevitable purchase or replacement of highway equipment and to facilitate future financial planning for the Town and to avoid the cost and expense of bonding and interest for the complete cost of such purchases; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Fiscal Officer of the Town of Lisbon is hereby directed to deposit and secure the moneys of this Reserve Fund in the manner provided by Section 10 of the General Municipal Law. The Chief Fiscal Officer may invest the moneys in the reserve fund in the manner provided by Section 11 of the General Municipal Law and consistent with the investment policy of the Town of Lisbon. Any interest earned or capital gains realized on the moneys so deposited or invested shall accrue to and become part of the reserve fund established by the Resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Fiscal Officer shall account for the reserve fund in a manner which maintains the separate identity of the reserve fund and shows the date and amount of each sum paid into the Fund, interest earned by the fund, capital gains or losses resulting from the sale of investments of the fund, the amount of date of each withdrawal from the fund, and the total assets of the fund, showing cash balance and a schedule of investments, and shall at the end of each fiscal year, render to the Town Board a detailed report of the operation and condition of the reserve fund; and

WHEREAS, Except as otherwise provided by law, expenditures from the reserve fund established by this Resolution shall be made only for the purpose for which the reserve fund is established. No expenditures shall be made from this reserve fund without the approval of this governing board and such additional actions or proceedings as may be required by Section 6-c of the general Municipal Law, the provisions of the Local Finance Law, or any other law, including a permissive referendum if required by subdivision 4 of Section 6-c of the General Municipal Law or any other law; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Pursuant to Section 6-c of the New York General Municipal Law, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the <u>Highway</u> Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund; and

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

TOWN OF LISBON RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL RESERVE FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE CAMPGROUND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT RESERVE FUND.

WHEREAS, this Board is in the process of establishing a five year financial plan and a 5 year capital purchase plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined it to be prudent and responsible to establish a reserve fund pursuant to §6-c of the New York General Municipal Law for the constructing, repairing, and maintaining the buildings, sites, infrastructure or any other physical public betterment capital improvement at the Campground.

WHEREAS, this capital reserve fund will facilitate future financial planning for the Town and to avoid the cost and expense of bonding and interest for the complete cost of such capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Fiscal Officer of the Town of Lisbon is hereby directed to deposit and secure the moneys of this Reserve Fund in the manner provided by Section 10 of the General Municipal Law. The Chief Fiscal Officer may invest the moneys in the reserve fund in the manner provided by Section 11 of the General Municipal Law and consistent with the investment policy of the Town of Lisbon. Any interest earned or capital gains realized on the moneys so deposited or invested shall accrue to and become part of the reserve fund established by the Resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Fiscal Officer shall account for the reserve fund in a manner which maintains the separate identity of the reserve fund and shows the date and amount of each sum paid into the Fund, interest earned by the fund, capital gains or losses resulting from the sale of investments of the fund, the amount of date of each withdrawal from the fund, and the total assets of the fund, showing cash balance and a schedule of investments, and shall at the end of each fiscal year, render to the Town Board a detailed report of the operation and condition of the reserve fund; and

WHEREAS, Except as otherwise provided by law, expenditures from the reserve fund established by this Resolution shall be made only for the purpose for which the reserve fund is established. No expenditures shall be made from this reserve fund without the approval of this governing board and such additional actions or proceedings as may be required by Section 6-c of the general Municipal Law, the provisions of the Local Finance Law, or any other law, including a permissive referendum if required by subdivision 4 of Section 6-c of the General Municipal Law or any other law; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Pursuant to Section 6-c of the New York General Municipal Law, there is hereby established a capital reserve fund to be known as the <u>Campground</u> <u>Capital Improvement Reserve Fund; and</u>
