Audit of Town of Lisbon Town Justice Court Records

WHEREAS, the NY State Unified Court System's Action Plan for Justice Courts includes initiatives to improve accountability and controls over Justice Court finances and records; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2019-a of the Uniform Justice Court Act, a yearly audit is required of the Town of Lisbon Justices, and Section 2019-a of the Uniform Justice Court Act and Town Law subsection 123 requires that Justices, provide his or her books, dockets, records, receipts, warrants, vouchers and canceled checks or check images at least annually and provide these court records and dockets to their respective Town Board, and that such records then be

examined and audited and when completed, the audit be approved and entered into the minutes of the board's proceedings; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Lisbon wishes to comply with such auditing procedures and general Municipal Law, and

WHEREAS, the Town has begun the audit and process to examine said records and dockets to be provided by Town Justice Fletcher and Town Justice Fonda for the three fiscal years beginning 1/1/17 to 12/31/19; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lisbon wishes to retain a person with expertise and knowledge of the Justice Court documents, processes, reporting requirements, SEI Systems, and General Municipal law related to said requirements,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Lisbon, wishes to hire Shari Stone to assist with this audit at an hourly rate of \$20 per hour account books and audited the monthly reports of the Town Justice the Hon. Philip Fonda and the Hon. Patricia Fletcher.
